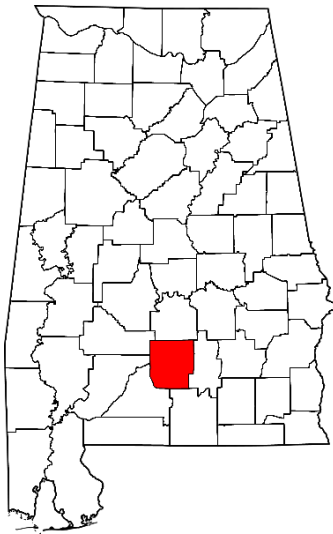

Program Overview

Butler County was created by the first session of the Alabama legislature on 1819 Dec. 13, from parts of Monroe and Conecuh Counties. It was named for Capt. William Butler, a soldier of the Creek War of 1813-14. Butler County lies in the south-central part of the state, and borders Lowndes, Crenshaw, Covington, Conecuh, Monroe, and Wilcox counties. Butler County encompasses 763 square miles. The county seat is located at Greenville, which was originally named Buttsville. Other towns and communities include Chapman, McKenzie, and Georgiana.

Healthy Kids will be the lead agency for the HIPPY program and it was organized in October of 1997 and began as a sponsor of the USDA Child Nutrition Food Program with six home day cares in the Butler County area of South Alabama. Currently, Healthy Kids serves 112 day care homes in the Central and South Alabama area.
