

Program Overview

Birmingham HIPPY is part of the Birmingham City Schools System and is in its second year of operation. It began by servicing two areas, but has now extended to accommodate student 3-5 years of age within the entire school system, especially targeting the students that are currently participating in the public pre-k programs within the system.
